#### LOCATION OF SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT

<b>Medical Room/ Emergency Treatment Room</b>	Behind the goal next to the Tea Hut
<b>Emergency equipment</b>	<u>Duo Fold Stretcher</u> – Home dressing Room  <u>Defibrillator</u> – One in the Home dressing Room and another in the club house (During first team home games the defibrillator from the home dressing room will be in the home dug out)
<b>First Aid Bags</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All teams or club events onsite will have a personal First Aid Bag</li> <li>2. A First Aid Bag can be found in the Medical Room</li> <li>3. Ice Packs will be offered and if needed, the Lead First Aider will provide on the day from their First Aid Bag</li> </ol>
<b>Use of the stretcher</b>	<p>The stretcher team will work in assistance with the Lead First Aider.</p> <p>If a player is stretched off, they will be moved directly to the Emergency Treatment Room or home changing room in order to be assessed by the Lead First Aider available at the time while waiting for medical services to arrive if required.</p>

## AMBULANCE ROUTES

<b>Pitch to Ambulance</b>	Ambulance will arrive in the car park located near the turnstiles and drive down behind the Eddie Diplock Stand where there are double metal gates (padlock code 19661) the ambulance can then drive into Bourne Stadium and on to the pitch
<b>Emergency Treatment/ Medical Room</b>	From the Emergency Treatment/ Medical Room turn right, through the double gates where the ambulance will be waiting
